

We are excited to finally turn this important corner in our community's response to the COVID-19 pandemic. As of January 11, Texas is currently in Phase 1B of COVID vaccine distribution. Appropriate healthcare, education, childcare, emergency services, and food and agriculture workers, as well as those age 65 and over, and persons 16 and over with at least one chronic medical condition, including pregnancy may register for vaccination through the Texas Department of State Health Services website.
