

# MONKEYPOX PROSPECT MEDICAL

## Signs and Symptoms

### Avoid!

1. Contact with the rash
2. Respiratory secretions
3. Touching items that came in contact with the rash



Fever



Headaches



Muscle Aches



Chills



Rash/Blister



Rashes appear anywhere in the body  
and last up to 2-4 weeks!



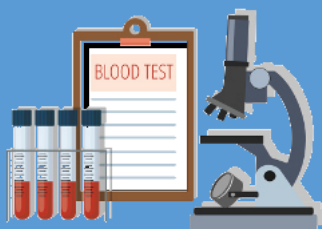
### PREVENTION

- **JYNNEOUS (Imavume, Imvanex)**
  - ⇒ 2 doses 28 days apart. Live, NON-replicating
  - ⇒ Full protection 2 weeks after 2nd dose
- **ACAM2000**
  - ⇒ Single Dose. Live, replicating vaccine
  - ⇒ Full protection after 4 weeks

### TREATMENT

- **TPOXX, ST-246 (Tecovirimat)\***
- **VISTIDE (Cidofovir)\***
- **VIGIV (Vaccinia Immune Globulin Intravenous)\***

\*Medications are available through the Strategic National Stockpile.  
Refer to fact sheet. Currently not FDA-approved for monkeypox



### When in doubt, Rule it out!

If the diagnosis is unclear, consider testing if there is:

- Exposure to someone with monkeypox
- Exposure to monkeypox contaminated objects
- Multiple sexual partners in area of known monkeypox outbreak.
