# Avoid!

- 1. Contact with the rash
- 2. Respiratory secretions
- 3. Touching items that came in contact with the rash





Headaches







**Muscle Aches** 

Chills

Rash/Blisters



Rashes appear <u>anywhere</u> in the body and last up to 2-4 weeks!



## **PREVENTION**

- JYNNEOUS (Imavume, Imvanex)
  - ⇒ 2 doses 28 days apart. Live, NON-replicating
  - ⇒ Full protection 2 weeks after 2nd dose
- ACAM2000
  - ⇒ Single Dose. Live, replicating vaccine
  - ⇒ Full protection after 4 weeks

### **TREATMENT**

- TPOXX, ST-246 (Tecovirimat)\*
- VISTIDE (Cidofovir)\*
- VIGIV (Vaccinia Immune Globulin Intravenous)\*

\*Medications are available through the Strategic National Stockpile.

Refer to fact sheet. Currently not FDA-approved for monkeypox



#### When in doubt, Rule it out!

If the diagnosis is unclear, consider testing if there is:

- Exposure to someone with monkeypox
- Exposure to monkeypox contaminated objects
- Multiple sexual partners in area of known monkeypox outbreak.
