Application Requirements

- PharmD degree from an accredited school of pharmacy
- Active pharmacist license or eligibility for licensure in the state of California. The resident must obtain pharmacist licensure from the California State Board of Pharmacy within 120 days of the start of the program.
- Letter of intent summarizing candidate's interest in managed care
- Current curriculum vitae
- Two (2) letters of recommendation (emailed directly from the letter-writers)
- Official pharmacy school transcript (emailed directly from the school)
- Wallet-sized photo of yourself
- Panel interview for select candidates (may be onsite or video interview; oral presentation may be required)
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
